11/29/2011	Rifle	Buck 7 points (120 lbs)	Welch Canyons	Hunting Welch Canyons with Ronald the second week of rifle season. We had seen very few deer. Tuesday 5:45 PM. Ronald had hunted every day before I came and other than the first couple of days had only seen a few deer. We were in his new hunting hut with a heater. Two does came out about 10 minutes before but did not even stay to eat at the feeder. The buck came from the cattle guard and walked right in front of us. Shot him in the neck and he fell DRT. His right brow tine was folded back on his head in a loop. Melissa and I hunted Thanksgiving weekend in Shattuck and she got her first buck. An 8 point (104 lbs) at 159 yards. Saturday. We were sitting in the pickup at 12:00 and the buck came out at 12:04. He ran about 20 yards into the trees.
10/30/2011	Black Powder	Buck 7 points (100 lbs)	Welch Canyons	Hunting with Ronald in his new hut. Last day of season. Had shot a buck Friday and we found two pools of blood where he had laid down but we never found any more blood and never found him. I did loose my ramrod out of my new CVA Accura Black Powder while searching. I had to use an arrow that had been in the back of the pickup to load bullets. Sunday 8:45 AM. Last day of season. Buck came out with a couple of does and I shot him and he ran to fence but did not jump even though the doe did. We had to track him up and down the ravines and finally found him at the bottom of a 40 foot ravine. Ricky brought out a four wheeler to pull him up.
10/28/2012	Black Powder	Doe	Welch Canyons	Friday 6:30 PM. Three does came out and I shot one. It ran the same direction as the buck I lost earlier, we couldn't find blood until a few feet from where she lay, it had turned back and was less than 50 yards from where I shot her.

12/3/2010	Rifle	Buck 4 points (100 lbs)	Welch Canyons	Hunting Welch Canyons with Ronald the second week of rifle season. We had seen very few deer. Friday 8:36 AM. I had to go home Saturday so when a small 4 point buck came out I went ahead and shot him. He fell right there.
11/26/2010	Rifle	Doe (68 lbs) [Melissa]	Trieber's Shattuck	Hunting Trieber family land in Shattuck with Melissa . Friday 5:30 PM. Our first year to hunt on this land. Set up a pop-up blind near a corner post and had deer all around us on the wheat field. This was Melissa's first deer to harvest. We stayed in Shattuck Friday night and Saturday night. We took the deer to Ronald's and hung it there. She got a shot a couple of bucks but missed.
10/29/2010	Black Powder	Buck 8 Points (180 lbs)	Welch Canyons	Hunting with Ronald at hut on Welch canyons. Buck came out at fence at about 100 yards, around 5:30 PM I shot and missed. This was the first buck we had seen on our land the whole week. He came back out at 6:40 PM and I was amazed by how big he was. Ronald looked at him to decide if he wanted to shoot but told me to "take him". I shot and he ran off. Right after he left another smaller buck and 4 does came out. We didn't want to spook them so we waited till dark to get out of the hut. We only had two small flashlights and we could not find him. We went into town and got some other lights and Ricky and Andy came back out with us. We could not find any blood. Just as we were about to give up we found him still on our land. I had shot just belows the spine and there was no exit wound so that explained no blood. This was the biggest body buck I have ever seen in this area.

10/25/2010	Black Powder	Doe (85 lbs)	Welch Canyons	<p>Monday morning 8:36 AM, hunting with Ronald in the hut. 5 does come out. Shot the largest one. She ran back into the trees and died after jumping the fence.. We were held prisoners in the hut for awhile after I shot the deer by a skunk that appears to think home is under the hut. Thursday October 28, about 6:30 PM a coyote came out and chased off the deer again and when he stepped out the next time I shot in the neck at 90 yards. He dropped right there. First coyote I ever shot and with black powder at that.</p>
11/24/2009	Rifle	Buck 10 Points (145 lbs)	Welch Canyons	<p>Tuesday Morning 9:15 AM, hunting with Ronald in the Hut at the Welch Canyons. Ronald had moved it to in front of a cedar tree closer to where I shot my buck last year. Several does had come out and we had seen several smaller bucks. I passed on a 9 point Monday morning. The buck stepped out at about 9:15 and I knew instantly that I wanted to harvest him. I shot and it was the first time I saw blood when I shot. He ran behind a cedar tree and then out of view. When we went to find him he had run into the base of a cedar tree and gone out the other side and was laying there. He was just about 20 yards from where I shot him. Melissa came out Friday after Thanksgiving and got her first shot at a doe. She missed. The deer better look out next year! We went on a cruise during Black Powder season so did not get to hunt.</p>

12/4/2008	Rifle	Doe (110 lbs)	Welch Canyons	<p>Thursday 8:30 AM, hunting alone. Ronald had to work. Two does and a Big 7 point buck came out at about 7:30 and he grazed 50 yards in front of me for almost 30 minutes. I waited for him to leave before I would shoot a doe. She came out at about 8:20 with a small doe. The turkeys were fighting beside the hut and made them nervous so they left. A few minutes later she came back out with two small does. She ran about 50 yards and jumped the fence on to Ellis' land. Thought she had gone down into ravine but she was behind a tree about 15 yards past fence.</p>
12/2/2008	Rifle	Buck 6 Points (110 lbs)	Welch Canyons	<p>Tuesday Afternoon 3:45 PM with Ronald. Ronald had rebuilt the hunting hut and set up on the open area by the cattle guard before Black powder. Between then and Rifle season he turned the hut around facing the open area. We put out 3 corn piles and this really drew in the deer and turkeys. The same small buck had come out for the last 4 days I had hunted on this location. A couple of other spikes had come out but no other bucks. I shot him at about 60 yards and he fell right there. I had taken lots of pictures of him on the days before I shot him. He had broken off the tip on one of his mainbeams between the day before and when I shot him. Saw lots of deer every day but very few bucks. Also saw lots of turkeys. Melissa went hunting with me on the Saturday and Sunday after Thanksgiving on the Ponderosa in a double bull blind but we didn't see any deer. Ronald shot a turkey with his Black Powder on the last day of Black Powder season.</p>

11/18/2007	Rifle	Buck 6 Points (117 lbs)	Welch Canyons	Sunday Afternoon 3:15 PM with Ronald. Had just gotten to hunting hut. Was discussing Centennial and singing Oklahoma Swing when we saw a buck walking across the canyon from us. Shot once and he walked off into the tree row about 20 yards away from where I shot him. Ronald didn't want to end the days hunting so didn't go across and check till 5 and wasn't sure if he was down. First time I used my deer cart. Ronald shot a buck the next Sunday morning that had been standing just out of the side of our hut. He went all the way down to the bottom of the ravine before he died. This is the first deer I got pictures of before it was shot. Ricky put one of my pictures I took up on his website.
10/31/2007	Black Powder	Buck 8 Points (140 lbs)	West of Webb	Wednesday Evening, hunting alone on ridge of bottom north of Webb on Saylor's. Saw a buck for a few seconds earlier on the edge of the bottom and decided I had to get closer. Leaned up against a tree right on the edge of the bottom. About 6:15 I saw a very small doe coming from my left and decided she was way to small to shoot, I let her go by and just as she was going to disappear I heard a buck grunt twice and he was chasing her. They ran around for a bit and I grunted at the buck. He stopped and I shot him once, he fell right in the same spot. I had to drag him 300 yards to the road. Then I couldn't get him into Beth's van. I rested for several minutes then finally loaded him. A few days later I bought my deer cart.
11/26/2006	Rifle	Buck 6 points (90 lbs)	Welch Canyons	Sunday Morning, hunting from hut with Ronald and a small buck stepped out near fence about 8:15 AM. One shot at 140 yards and he fell in same spot.

11/24/2006	Rifle	Doe (95 lbs)	Webb	<p>CBS closed on Friday after Thanksgiving so was able to hunt 3 days. Saw a wounded buck Friday morning at Welch Canyons, but off our land. Saturday morning Hunting near Webb. Troy dropped me off where I could watch a spot where there was a "Y" of pipeline crossings. First saw doe at about 8:20 and watched it till 8:45 when it was getting ready to go out of sight behind some trees. Shot at about 110 yards and she fell right there. Spent next 2 hours dragging her to where Troy was going to meet me. When he got there he told me he could have just driven up right to the spot.</p>
11/1/2006	Black Powder	Doe (92 lbs)	Blackjack "X" near Webb	<p>I scheduled the wrong week for vacation, that's when I found out <u>Black Powder is always the 4th Saturday in October</u>. I was only able to get Monday-Wednesday off. Went to Ponderosa Saturday morning because Ronald had a college thing with Ronna but didn't see anything. Sunday morning saw 18 does and 3 bucks at the canyons in the hut. After that only saw a couple of does the next 5 times. Wednesday Ronald went to work and I went with Troy and he put me in a ground blind in the blackjack "X" near Webb. Three does came out at 7:00 AM and I shot the biggest one. Had to track her about 30 yards, when the blood trail ended I was concerned that I lost her. Looked to my left and there she was.</p>

11/25/2005	Rifle	Buck 6 points 4/2 (138 lbs)	Welch Canyons	<p>The year of the missing. I was still recovering from "Walking Pneumonia". Missed 4 times with Black Powder , 5 times with rifle and once with Pistol. Friday morning 9:30, sitting on side of ledge. Six does coming from the West behind us, a buck that we had seen earlier joined up with them and when they came out in front of us there was one doe and one buck. I could barely make him out in my scope because of the glare. He finally stepped out of the shadows and I got him with one shot. Ronald had shot a buck a couple of days before and he fell down, but got back up and ran away. That's the only time Ronald shot. We saw lots of deer every day. The last night, Sunday, I decided to try to get a doe with my pistol. Three does were coming my way but a buck got on them and started them running. It was nearly dark and I shot at bout 50 yards but missed.</p>
11/27/2004	Rifle	Antlerless (50 lbs)	Welch 40	<p>4:30 PM Saturday. My fuel pump had gone out the night before leaving me stranded between Watonga and Oakwood. Ronald came over and picked me up. We left the truck overnight and came back the next morning and he towed me back using a chain. We got the fuel pump changed by about 3 pm at David Rose's house and ran and changed clothes and went out to see if I could get a doe. Walked in where Ronald had shot a buck earlier that week and there were two does out already. Walked up and leaned on a fence post and shot one. Had brought rattling antlers to play a little so rattled them a bit since we were thru. Two more does came up but no bucks.</p>

11/23/2004	Rifle	Buck 6 points (95 lbs)	Ron Cox / West	4:15 Pm Tuesday. Hunting from a hunting hut with Ronald. Had been raining all week. Had to leave at 4:30 to be able to go to a basketball game at Canton. A big bobcat walked across the canyon wall across from us and while I was watching it, Ronald said, "there's a buck". I started to pull my binoculars back up and he pulled them back down and said "get your gun up!". I shot at about 200 yards and he fell down immediately. He had very small horns and only one brow tine. Ronald had Shot a 8 point the day before from that hut. "It's a biggen, Boom!"
10/25/2004	Black Powder	Doe (90 lbs)	Squires	8:15 AM Monday. Hunting alone in Squires far East tree stand. Two does and a fawn came out. Biggest doe stomping around and sniffing. She came within 20 yards of me and when she turned to walk away I shot. She ran about 30 yards. Had to work Tuesday thru Thursday and came back out. Went with Ronald to "Daniels" land and saw lots of turkey and deer, took first pictures with binocular camera and got pictures made on snapfish website
11/30/2002	Rifle	Buck 4 Points (110 Lbs)	Ron Cox / East	5:00 PM Saturday. Had to work all week at 7-Eleven so only had Saturday and Sunday off. Saw 4 bucks chasing a Doe around that morning on the West side but they were off our land and out of range. That evening Ronald and I sat at the top of the pipeline crossing and saw nothing. About 5:00 Ronald stood up and looked behind us. There was a buck and two does. I stood up and shot. He ran about 20 yards, turned around and ran back to almost the same spot and fell. Checked him in at the Taloga Quick Stop.

11/20/2001	Rifle	Buck 11 Points (160 lbs)	Ron Cox / West	8:00 AM Tuesday temperature about 20 degrees, hunting alone on Ron Cox land "school lease" North of Taloga on West side of highway. Saw buck following doe. First time I saw a deer and at 300+ yards could tell without Binoculars it was a buck. It took him 30 minutes to get to his closest point to me. Shot once and he jumped but stood there. I had hit him but because of the angle, the bullet had not gotten any vital organs. Shot second time and clipped spine. Drove down to him and had to shoot third time to kill. This is the Deer I have mounted on the wall. Brad got his first Buck (8 points 104 lbs) on Sunday morning on this same land. Took 3 1/2 hours to drag Brad's deer from the other side of the ravine. Saturday Morning Ronald shot an 8 point here also.
11/18/2001	Rifle	Doe (46 lbs)	Squires	Hunting alone, 9:00 AM Sunday, Hunting Squires' far east Texas Tree Stand. Doe stepped out just past the trees to the far East.
11/2/2001	Black Powder	Buck 7 Points (103 lbs)	Squires	5:45 PM Friday, Hunting alone in hut on island. First year with my new CVA black powder rifle. Buck spooked and ran to just below the hut. He ran about 75 yards and fell in an area that had been brush hogged. I leaned out the hut window and watched him fall. I shot at a doe a few minutes later but couldn't find any sign that I had hit it.
11/20/2000	Rifle	Buck 8 Points (98 lbs)	Squires	Hunting alone, 10:00 AM, drizzle, cold. Hunting Squires' far east Texas tree stand. About to give up when I heard a buck grunt. A moment or so later a doe came out and shortly afterwards a buck came out. Brad got his first doe on Thanksgiving Day on Ron Cox's Land east side of highway

11/4/2000	Black Powder	Doe (90 lbs)	Squires	Borrowed Gordona Rowell's (Worked with her at Jacks Service Company) Husbands Thompson Center Fire 50 cal, hunting alone on Squires' far east Texas tree stand. Missed Buck the night before (Bullet damaged when he loaded gun?)
11/28/1999	Rifle	Doe	Next to Pollack's	Last day of season with Ronald. Hunting on Gore land next to Pollack's.
11/23/1998	Rifle	Doe	Squires	Hunting alone. First one I completely field dressed on my own. Took 3 hours to find deer in tall grass. Hunting Ponderosa far east Texas Tree Stand.
11/21/1998	Rifle	Buck (Busted Antlers)	Squires	With Ricky and Wesley Sehi (all three got one opening morning. Hunting middle stand in tree.
Nov-97	Rifle	Antlerless Buck	Pollack's	First year with my 25.06 (Three shots, 1st nicked, second missed, third down). Hunting corner post with Ronald. Turned around and when I looked back I thought I saw him standing again! It was another deer!
Nov-96	Rifle	Doe	Squires	Hunting with Ricky on Ponderosa. Borrowed Ricky's 25.06 rifle. Hunting middle area behind round hay bales. Was so dark I could not see deer except with the scope
